



On April 1, 2011, the Toronto Preservation Board approved a report to designate under the Ontario Heritage Act the heritage buildings and historical landscape elements within the Amedeo Garden Court apartment complex. On April 1, 2011 Longo Properties (owners of the Amedeo Garden Court apartment complex), submitted an Official Plan Amendment to the Etobicoke York District Community Planning Department. The application calls for the demolition and/or relocation of the heritage buildings and landscape elements. On April 21, 2011, the proposal by the Toronto Preservation Board was forwarded to Etobicoke York Community Council for approval. Instead, the local Councillor and lawyer for Longo Properties requested a deferral and asked that the issue be dealt with under the Mimico 20/20 Revitalization Action Plan.

The Toronto Preservation Board at their meeting on April 1, 2011 refused to defer the issue, arguing that a decision to preserve a building is done irrespective of development. The building is either historic or it is not. In this case, the historic buildings and landscaping elements within the Amedeo Garden Court apartment complex have a rich history (see back of flyer).
